On September 11, 2009, the Rock Tavern Snow Riders will be hosting a Golf Outing at the Stonyford Golf Club in Montgomery, New York, and are soliciting sponsors for the event, including sponsors for each hole and tee on the Golf Course and businesses willing to donate product for raffle prizes and giveaways.

The Rock Tavern Snow Riders was founded in 2001 in an effort to promote safe riding in Orange County, and expanded our charter to ensure open space would be available for outdoor recreational activity. Working with both hunting groups and bird lovers alike, the Rock Tavern Snow Riders lobbied to protect the 7,000 acre Stewart buffer lands, resulting in the successful Stewart Management Plan, in which hunters, horseback riders, bird watchers, riders, cyclists and joggers are guaranteed access to the trails and woods surrounding Stewart Airport. The Snow Riders have actively maintained and groomed these trails, both during season, and off-season, and have provided maps of the trails for all users. The Snow Riders have also created and posted signage throughout the trails to prevent lost riders and cyclists, and are the first called by the NYS DEC when a snowmobile rider is injured or missing. Happily, our rescue sled is not used that often. The club emphasizes safe, fun riding and advocates for all users for the Stewart buffer lands.

The Snow Riders are also continually involved in community activities, from sponsoring Little League teams and supporting Girl Scout and Boy Scout troops, to raising money for members of the Orange County community who have been stricken with illness. Most recently, the Snow Riders raised significant funds for a family affected by devastating cancer and another in which a young boy lost an eye through an accident.

All of these activities take time, commitment and money, and we hope that you are willing to assist the Snow Riders in furthering the cause of safe, enjoyable recreational activities in Orange County.
